GUIDE TO TRAVELING AWARD OF IPE TRAINING COURSE 2015 at Kusatsu, Gunma

Gunma University offers traveling award to Educators or health practitioners who wish to learn IPE at our university under the IPE training course (Gunma University) for 2014 as follows:

1. QUALIFICATIONS

Educators or health practitioners who are interested in the introduction of IPE curricula to their educational/health care institutions, especially in the Western Pacific Region.

2. NUMBER OF POSITION

Maximum four to five persons (First come, first served). And maximum two persons per one institute.

3. APPLICATION DEADLINE

30 April 2015

4. DELIVERY OF THE APPLICATION

You must mark "11. Traveling Award i) I will apply the Traveling Award" in IPE Training Course Application Form with the circle.

5. BENEFITS

- ① Transportation to Japan: Each grantee will be provided, according to his/her itinerary and route as designated by Gunma University, with an economy class air ticket from the international airport closest to his/her place of residence to Narita International Airport and travel expenses within Japan (from Narita to Gunma University). Expenses such as inland transportation from his/her place of residence to the nearest international airport, airport tax, airport usage charges, and special taxes on overseas travel will be borne by the grantee (the place of residence of the grantee shall in principle be the address stated in the application form).
- ② Transportation from Japan: The grantee who returns to his/her home country will be provided, upon application, with an economy class air ticket for a flight from Narita International Airport to the international airport closest to his/her place of return, and travel expenses within Japan (from Gunma university to Narita International Airport). Note: Insurance premiums for travel to/from Japan shall be borne by the grantee. The airport the grantee departs from or returns to must be an airport of the country of his/her nationality.
- 3 Accommodation Fees: Fees for accommodation will be paid by Gunma University.
